## About Our Classes

Fabric Etc. 2 is a very fun place to learn! We take a lot of pride in bringing you the best instruction, in a relaxed, friendly atmosphere. We ask that you help us be sure things go smoothly for you. **The classroom opens 15 min before scheduled class time.**

You can register for class either at the store or by phone. Fees are due at the time of registration and can be paid in person at the store, by credit card over the phone, or with a check through the mail. A paid class fee is the only thing that guarantees your spot in class and prevents you from being "bumped" when the class fills.

Class registration closes three (3) days prior to the scheduled class date. No fee will be refunded or credits issued for a missed class. Our commitment to your instructors does not allow make-up classes. Refunds or in-store credits will be issued only if: (a) the store cancels the class, or (b) you notify us three (3) days prior to the scheduled class date.

Only registered students may attend a class. Any one "sitting-in" much also register.

In order to provide high-quality sewing education, we ask that materials and supplies for classes be purchased at Fabric Etc. 2 whenever possible. Students are eligible to receive a 10% discount off regular priced merchandise for class materials and/or for purchase of regularly priced merchandise on the day of class.

Please refrain from using colognes and perfumes; someone in class may have an allergic reaction to fragrances.

### Class Skill Levels

To get the full benefit and enjoyment from our classes, we've rated many of them by sewing skill level. With each class you take, you'll be gaining more experience and mastering those skills needed for more advanced classes.

**Beginner** - Requires basic sewing skills and ability to use your sewing machine, but no knowledge of quilting or embroidery techniques.

**Confident Beginner** - Requires skills using a rotary cutter, maintaining a 1/4-inch seam allowance and confidence using your machine. These classes will expand your sewing horizons.

**Proficient** - Requires being very comfortable with all of the above sewing basics. In these classes you will learn more advanced skills and techniques.

### Serger Savvy I

After you take this class, you'll go home with samples and information to fill a notebook for future referencing. Learn basic threading, tension adjustments, stitch width and length adjustments, four-thread stitch techniques and more. Discover what differential feed is, and how it works on your serger.
